PROGRAMA ANALITICO. CONTENIDOS POR UNIDADES:

Unidad 1

■ ***By the Sea:*** Present simple of be: I, you, we, they. Lexical field: Countries, nationalities and languages.

■ ***By the pool:*** Present simple of be: he, she, it. Lexical field: Adjectives for people and places. Countable nouns: a/ an, some and any. Plural nouns: regular and irregular. Describing people and places.

■ ***At the reception:*** Possessive adjectives: my, your, his, her, its, our, their. Lexical field: Alphabet, spelling and numbers.

■ ***In the café:*** This, that, these, those. Lexical field: Money and numbers. What's the time?

Unidad 2

■ ***All work and play...*** Present simple: I, you, we, they. Prepositions in time expressions. Lexical field: Jobs. Leisure: activities and places.

■ ***Family, friends and neighbours.*** Present simple: he, she, it. Frequency adverbs. Lexical field: People in your life. Reading for pleasure: He mail- She mail.

■ ***Lifestyle.*** Love, like, don't mind, hate. Can, can't for ability. Lexical field: Likes and dislikes. Leisure activities and holidays.

■ ***Secrets and lies.*** Present continuous: now, around now. Lexical field: Making a telephone conversation. Reading for pleasure: Lost opportunities.

Unidad 3

■ ***You are what you wear.*** Have got and has got, have and has. Lexical field: Clothes and shopping.

■ ***Have we got news for you?*** Past simple of regular and irregular verbs. Time expressions for the past. Lexical field: News stories. Reading for pleasure: The red dress.

■ ***Round the world.*** Past simple of irregular verbs. Past simple of be: was/ were. Lexical field: Traveling round the world.

■ ***Trains and boats and planes.*** Past simple: travel verbs Lexical field: Types of transport and travel verbs. Reading for pleasure: Rats.
